


Rose Hill staff is committed to deepening their understanding of reading and math curriculum along with state standards by working in collaboration with grade level teammates and specialists.

- Grades K-2 Reading: 91% of students at benchmark on end of year DIBELS
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 65% at standard
- Grades 3-5 Math: 70% at standard
- Grade 5 science: 64% at standard
- Achievement gap: Students receiving ELL services in 5th grade will move up a level
- School Effectiveness: Increase to 50% the percentage of teachers who agree with the statement: "The staff works in teams across grade levels to help increase student learning"
- Attendance: 98% daily attendance rate for all kindergarten students
- Discipline: Reduce office referrals by 25%




3rd Grade English Language Arts




4th Grade English Language Arts




5th Grade English Language Arts




3rd Grade Math



4th Grade Math




5th Grade Math


